Listening Guide

Believers experience the Holy Spirit, Satan's influence, the Sanhedrin's jealousy, and the Lord's provision, and though flogged, rejoice they are worthy to suffer for Christ.

1. The church, Christ's body of believers, flourishes with \_\_\_\_\_ believers, but death sets in when we allow sin to flourish. 1 Cor 5:7

1. One of the Trinity: God the Father, God the Son, God the Holy Spirit. 5:4

3. Jesus's Spirit. Luke 21:15 "I will give you utterance."
4. God's Spirit. Acts 5:4 Lied to God. 5:9, Spirit of the Lord.
5. Christ's \_\_\_\_\_ to a believer at the moment of a person's salvation, Acts 2:38, 5:32
6. A seal (2 Cor 1:22, Eph 1:13) for the promise of what is to come - the day of redemption (Eph 4:30); the marriage supper of the Lamb. (Rev 19:9)
7. The baptism of the Holy Spirit is a \_\_\_\_\_ time occurrence. Acts 2:38, 1 Jn 2:27
8. The filling of the Holy Spirit is to be continually \_\_\_\_\_. Acts 4:8, 31
9. A believer is to continually live \_\_\_\_\_ with the Holy Spirit. Eph 5:18
